### **Luca BATTAGLINI**

Full Professor in [Animal production in mountain environment](#) and [Ecology, hygiene and welfare in livestock farming](#) in the Dep. Agriculture, Forestry and Food Science (AGRIFORFOOD ) of the University of Torino (Italy). Member of NatRISK - Research Center on Natural Risk in Mountain and Hilly Environments From 2006 to 2013 President of the Interfaculty Course in Alpine Science and Culture. The research activity mainly concerns livestock farming systems sustainability for land conservation, cattle, sheep and goats breeding, milk and cheese production. Many of his trials are carried on in order to check the possibility of a real transfer of the results. He has published almost 260 scientific papers, lots of them on referred national and international journals and conference proceedings. Main field of interest of the scientific production are: i) sustainability and ethics of livestock farming systems for land conservation and characteristics of typical products (milk, cheese, meat); ii) variation factors of milk yield and quality in dairy cow, sheep and goat; iii) pasture systems and their influence on animal production in hill and mountainous environment; iv) sustainability of livestock systems in marginal area; v) characteristics and products quality of local breeds.
